THE AVICENNA SCHOOL

CODE OF CONDUCT

The Avicenna School places emphasis on discipline. Suspension is a serious warning. On most counts the second infraction will lead to expulsion.

It is obligatory for all students to follow the set rules and expectations in order that a warding school environment are ensured. Failure to follow them would result in disciplinary action and imposition of penalties of any nature and severity as the school would deem appropriate (penalties include suspension or expulsion from school without warning).

- **Maintain** discipline at all times and choose behaviors that do not tarnish the reputation of the student himself/herself; their family or that of the school.
- Accord **due** respect to the teachers and to the supporting staff members, whether administrative or domestic.
- **Communicate** in respectful language and display modest behavior and conduct.
- **Wear** proper and **complete** school uniform and school ID card when coming to school. Without **complete** uniform, and ID card **no** student **would** be allowed to enter the school premises.
- Boys must keep their hair above the collar line.
- Girls must tie a neat pony tail incase or short hair or a plait in case of longer hair.
- **Interact** with and treat peers with **understanding**. Name calling;teasing;bullying,harassment;intimidation;or violence would result in immediate penalties.
- **Not to smoke** in or (in school uniform) **outside** school; this would result in immediate penalties.
- Possession or consumption of drugs or liquor in or outside school would result in immediate expulsion from the school.
- **Consult** a teacher or the **administrative** staff to sort out any differences amongst students which may result In a fight. **Regardless of who started a fight, students found indulging in any such destructive activity would Be subject to immediate penalties (including suspension or expulsion).**
- **Not to use unfair means** (including cheating and plagiarism) during examinations/assessments.
- Any student who commits the stated offence would be asked to leave the examination room and would receive a failing grade in that particular examination/assessment.
- **Treat** school property with care and consideration. For any intentional of unintentional damage to school property an appropriate price would be charged in addition *to any* other penalty (suspension or expulsion).
- **Not to tamper** with any equipment in the computer laboratory.
- **Not to litter** in the school premises.
